The Regular meeting of the Fenner Town Board was called to order at 8: 03PM by Supervisor Jones with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilperson Strack motioned to accept the April Town Board meeting minutes. Seconded by Councilperson Wester Approved by the board-

Clerk's Monthly Report as presented by Clerk Kelli Stone, motioned to accept by Councilperson Wester, Seconded by Councilperson Cody. Approved by the board.

The Town Supervisor's report was presented by Supervisor Jones, reports were given for April 2026, Councilperson Pushlar motioned to accept the Town Supervisor's Monthly Report as presented, seconded by Councilperson Strack, approved by the board.

The Highway Superintendent report was presented by Town Supervisor and is available for review at the town office-The Board unanimously said that all Town of Fenner DPW workers did an exceptional job during clean up days!

New Business- PRESENTATION FOR FREE CENTER (PHIL Rose)

Report on Clean up Days turnout – the 2-day event had a solid flow both days even with the weather not being great next year - the town is thinking about moving away from Mother's Day weekend and having it either before or after that weekend next year. The town has not received the final total from the landfill but should have by June's meeting

The Clerk is working with CAVAC to hold First aid and Cpr training for employees and dates will be coming TBA- the training will be at the CAVAC facility.

Update on the Free Center- Resident Phil Rose the director of the Free center presented to the board all the things going on at the facility, he mentioned the Treasurer of the Free Center will be stepping away from that position and they are looking for a replacement. Mr. Rose also said that

for the 24-25 season there had been 1,383 people from all over the country and aboard that have been on a tour of the facility and the Free Center is becoming a destination. Mr. Rose always thanked the Town of Fenner DPW department saying they are always a pleasure to deal with and always willing to help with whatever maintenance is needed at the Free Center. Mr. Rose will be back at another time to keep the board updated on the Free Center, The Town Clerk called the non- emergency number to verify the address that if an emergency arises, they have the correct address and tax map number for the facility, and the nonemergency staff verified and sent over verification that was sent to Mr. Rose.

The Town board unanimously passed the proposal for Profit and sense to be reappointed as the Town's accounting and payroll department.

Church update: Looking for a part time contractor about 10-15 hours a week to help in restoration and repair we will post listing and contact info on our webpage and Facebook. The renovations are coming along and there has been a lot of work done on the property, and church.

County updates: Sales tax is up – Town of Fenner was one of the highest in Mortgage tax for Madison County – a lot of growth is happening in the Town of Fenner

Old Business: waiting on new Flags to arrive to replace our flag on the pole

Council person Cody received an agreement from the Caz youth board that all municipalities will sign and send back-
