Are you a small business interested in expanding? Are you an entrepreneur working on a start-up business? Apply now for \$5,000 to \$35,000 in grant funding!
The deadline to apply is
March 2nd, 2026

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Existing or to-be-formed businesses with five or fewer employees, including owner(s)
- Business must be located in Madison County
- Sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, LLC, LLP, cooperative, or any other legal form of business may apply. Not-for-profit corporations and entities are not eligible.

GRANT REQUIREMENTS

- If your household income is above the required threshold, you must create at least one full-time equivalent job made available to low-to-moderate-income (LMI) individuals. See the application for more information about income requirements.
- Funds must be matched by a minimum of 10% owner equity. Equity contribution must be provided as cash, not associated with debt of any kind. Awardees must complete an approved SBDC small business training
- All funds will be received on a reimbursement basis

ELIGIBLE USES OF FUNDS

- Equipment and furnishings
- Inventory
- Marketing and website development
- Payroll
- Other operating costs
- Other working capital
- Grant funds may NOT be used for construction, renovations, leasehold improvements, or demolition
